This exhibition has been brought to Australia with the assistance of Koru Contemporary Art and Tasmanian Craft Fair.

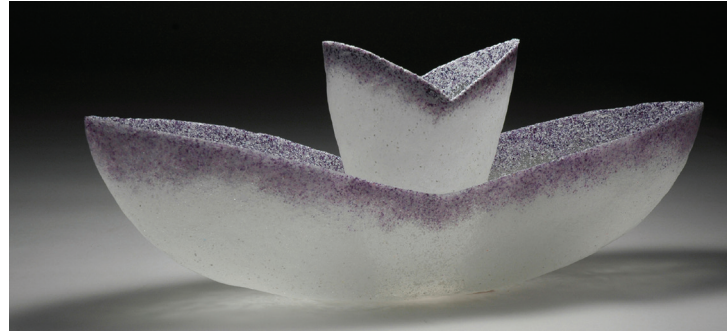


Image detail: Etsuko Nishi, Lavender, 2008, Pate De Verre, H15xW48xD13cm
